



TACTICAL WORKSHOP FOR MANAGERS OF ANALYSTS

OBJECTIVE

- **Tasking Issues (especially re RIPA, and justification for action)**
- **Use of Product and Implications (as above)**

This 2-day workshop is designed to give a snapshot of the 10-day course delivered to operational analysts. The course is delivered as both an 'open' course at Wyboston Lakes, or it can be delivered at a venue of your choice, for example, if your organisation wanted to host a course at a set fee for the course.
